INAUGURATION OF RURAL HAAT AT LANJIGARH



To boost local livelihoods and improve market access for farmers, a Rural Haat has been developed in Lanjigarh with financial support from Vedanta Limited - Aluminium Business and NABARD - National Bank for Agriculture & Rural Development. Spread over 2.5 acres of land, the Haat includes 36 shops with electrification, a vendor shed with a 500-person capacity, sanitation and drinking water facilities, a waste disposal pit, and a 150-meter connecting road. Designed as a full-fledged weekly-cum-daily market, the Rural Haat will directly benefit 500 farmers and indirectly impact 5,000 people from 50 villages by offering a platform for small and marginal farmers, SHGs, and local producers to sell their produce directly to consumers. The market is expected to strengthen the local agri-value chain by facilitating better price realization and reducing the dependency on middlemen. It also aims to encourage entrepreneurship among rural women and youth by providing a structured space for economic participation.

The Rural Haat inauguration was graced by Shri Pawar Sachin Prakash, IAS, Collector-cum-District Magistrate, and Mr. Pranab Kumar Bhattacharyya, CEO, Vedanta Limited - Aluminium Business, as the Chief Guests. Mr. Maheswar Das, DDM NABARD; Mr. SISIR TARAFDER, CSR Head - Vedanta, Mrs. Kamala Patra, Block Chairman, Lanjigarh; Mrs. Saraswati Munda, Sarpanch, Lanjigarh; Mr. Jugal Kishore Pattnayak, MD - Mahashakti Foundation; Mr. Sridhar Pesnia, President, Anchalik Bikash Parishad, attended as Guests of Honor, making the event a remarkable milestone for rural economic empowerment.



TPWODL TEAM'S FIELD VISIT

The Tata Power Western Odisha Distribution Ltd. (TPWODL) team recently conducted an extensive monitoring and verification visit to the watershed project area of Gochadengen GP in M. Rampur Block. The primary purpose of the visit was to thoroughly review on-ground progress and actively engage with key community stakeholders to assess impact, gather feedback, and ensure sustainable outcomes. During the insightful field visit, team members interacted with project staff, local community members, and volunteers, observed critical interventions such as check dams, drop structures, and plantation sites, and discussed detailed plans to maintain, strengthen, and enhance the watershed's long-term functionality and community ownership.



WADI PROJECT BOOSTS ORGANIC FARMING



ORGANIC RETAIL OUTLET INAUGURATED AT SAHASPUR

The WADI team of Mahashakti Foundation has significantly contributed to the success of the **NABARD - National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development**-supported TDF-WADI project in Gudvella. Strengthened community mobilization and strong relationship-building efforts led to improved plant growth and higher survival rates. Farmers have started residing in their WADI fields by constructing small huts and have promoted diversified cropping with maize, banana, watermelon, pumpkin, and other intercrops. The project also initiated organic farming practices through the use of pot manure, Jeevamruta, and vermicompost, actively promoting the message of sustainable agriculture. Additionally, diversified livelihood activities such as broom binding, Badi making, and training on straw mushroom cultivation were introduced to support the overall development of the community.

An organic retail outlet was inaugurated at Sahaspur Gram Panchayat under Maneswar Block in Sambalpur district. The outlet was officially inaugurated by Mr. Dibakar Biswal, Sarpanch of Sahaspur, in the presence of local farmers, the Agriculture Officer, Naib Sarpanch, FPO members, FFS farmers, and PRI representatives. This initiative, implemented by Mahashakti Foundation and supported by **Tata Power Western Odisha Distribution Limited**, aims to promote organic farming practices, enhance market access for rural farmers, and ensure the availability of chemical-free, healthy produce for local consumers through a reliable local supply chain. The community warmly welcomed the opening of the outlet, expressing optimism that it would contribute to improved farmer incomes, better health outcomes, and foster a growing shift towards sustainable and eco-friendly agricultural practices in the region.

OFFICIALS VISIT APPLIQUE TRAINING CENTRE



Ms. Prabina Nayak, District Director of Handicrafts, along with Ms. Arpita Mohanty, Assistant Promotional Officer, visited our Applique Training Centre supported by **YES FOUNDATION** at Banamalipur. During their visit, they engaged with the artisans, discussing crucial aspects of the program such as the training structure, stipend support, provision of raw materials and tool kits, and the promising livelihood opportunities this initiative unlocks for women artisans.





JUJOMURA PRODUCER GROUP'S MARKET SUCCESS

Collective marketing of watermelon was carried out by the Maa Jharigudi Producer Group from Dhadumunda village in Jujomura block of Sambalpur district. A total of 44 quintals of watermelon were collectively marketed at a selling price of ₹6 per kg, generating a total revenue of ₹26,400. This initiative was facilitated by the APC team of Jujomura under Mahashakti Foundation, with support from the Government of Odisha. The effort ensured better price realization for farmers and strengthened the group's capacity for collective sales and market linkage. The initiative has encouraged other farmer groups in the region to adopt similar marketing strategies and reinforced the importance of institutional support in achieving scale and profitability.

SETUP OF GOAT SHALA UNDER IVDP



Mahashakti Foundation, in collaboration with **LTIMindtree Foundation**, has established three Goat Shalas in Paikmal, Gudvella, and Madanpur Rampur Blocks under the Integrated Village Development Program. Designed by Human Venture Pvt Ltd, these durable, PVC-based Goat Shalas replace traditional bamboo sheds, offering better hygiene, durability, and disease prevention. Their innovative design ensures easy waste removal, reducing goat mortality and improving productivity. This initiative enhances goat farming practices, boosting farmers' income and profitability.



BLOCK LEVEL TRAINING ON SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS

Project SAKHI and Shaktimayee Foundation, supported by **Vedanta Limited - Aluminium Business**, had the privilege of participating in the Block Level Training on Sustainable Development Goals organized by the District Planning & Monitoring Unit & the District Administration of Kalahandi. The training session was graced by Block Development Officer of Lanjigarh, as the Chief Guest and facilitated by District Planning Officer, Block Agriculture Officer & Deputy Director, DPMU. A wide range of crucial topics such as SDG localization, mapping, assessments, convergence with government schemes, and the role of civil society were discussed. The event brought together NGOs and PRI members for collaboration and knowledge exchange. Visitors also toured Project Sakhi implementing organization - Mahashakti Foundation's office. The event marked a significant step in aligning local efforts with global goals and reinforcing our commitment to sustainable community empowerment.

SMART CLASSROOMS IN 15 SCHOOLS OF GANJAM



Mahashakti Foundation, with support from **HDFC Bank Parivartan**, has launched the Technology-Integrated Smart Classroom project in 15 schools - 8 in Buguda and 7 in Polasara blocks of Ganjam district. This initiative aims to enhance the quality of education by incorporating technology-driven smart classrooms, fostering a more engaging and interactive learning environment. The project is expected to improve learning outcomes, increase student engagement, and strengthen teacher capacity to integrate technology into their teaching methods. The installation and fitting work for the smart classrooms has been completed, ensuring that the schools are now equipped with the necessary technological infrastructure to transform the learning experience.

INTEGRATED PEST MANAGEMENT (IPM) SUPPORT



Amid the challenges posed by climate change, IPM plays a vital role in fostering climate-resilient agriculture. In this initiative, 200 farmers were assisted in adopting eco-friendly and safe methods for preparing IPM solutions with the support of **HDFC Bank - Parivartan**. They applied products such as neem oil, neem cake, and installed yellow and blue sticky traps along with other IPM tools on their farms. To support learning and knowledge-sharing, lead farmers organized field visits allowing peer-to-peer engagement and hands-on learning.

SCHOOL AND ANGANWADI INFRASTRUCTURE REVAMPED



Under the IVDP implemented supported by **LTIMindtree Foundation**, 6 Anganwadi Centres and 7 Government Upper Primary Schools across Paikmal, Gudvella, and M Rampur blocks were repaired and renovated to ensure a safer, more hygienic, and child-friendly learning environment. Extensive upgrades including building renovation, exterior painting, installation of drinking water points with RO systems, handwash points, water boring, toilet construction, fencing, and shed construction were also developed.

In a concerted effort to preserve Odisha’s rich legacy of handicrafts and cultural traditions while empowering its artisan communities, TPCODL, in partnership with Mahashakti Foundation, has launched the Samriddhi Project—an initiative aligned with TPCODL’s community development motto, “Powering Transformation.” This program aims to support artisans through skill enhancement, creative marketing strategies, and sustainable income generation by institutionalizing processes that elevate both their craft and market access.

As part of this initiative, the first-ever "Samriddhi Utsav" was organized at Kala Bhoomi, Shilpi Vihar, Gandamunda, Bhubaneswar, serving as a vibrant platform to celebrate the achievements of Odisha’s artisans and demonstrate the on-ground impact of the Samriddhi Program. The event showcased: Exhibitions of traditional crafts such as Palm Leaf engraving, Pattachitra painting, applique work, handloom weaving, Jute Products and Dhokra art, presented by over 200 artisans from districts including Khordha, Dhenkanal, Kalahandi, and Cuttack. Live artisan demonstrations and display of prototype models of training centres cum galleries, integrating the “Architecture of Care” concept inspired by Tata Power, emphasizing care, community, and craftsmanship. The launch of the **Samriddhi Product Catalogue** and **Kala Patrika**, a quarterly newsletter promoting handcrafted products and sharing stories of artisan resilience and innovation.

A RISING MODEL OF FARMER EMPOWERMENT IN BALANGIR

Formed on 8th March 2022, Ghasiendevi Farmer Producer Company Limited, operating in Balangir Block of Odisha, has quickly emerged as a model of farmer empowerment through collective farming, rural entrepreneurship, and sustainable agribusiness. What sets Ghasiendevi FPC apart is its inclusive approach, enabling small and marginal farmers to actively participate in value chain processes that were previously beyond their reach. With visionary leadership and strong grassroots efforts, this FPC is creating a meaningful impact in the lives of its farmer members, both economically and socially. The company has grown into a trusted platform for farmer welfare and business development. With 456 shareholder farmers, a share capital of ₹9 lakh, and an impressive business turnover of ₹85 lakh in FY 2024–25, Ghasiendevi FPC ensures timely access to quality seeds, fertilizers, and bio-inputs to farmers at fair and affordable prices. The organization's decentralized input supply system ensures last-mile delivery, reducing the dependency of farmers on external private vendors.

Output procurement activities involve the aggregation and collective marketing of agricultural produce such as potato, watermelon, onion, and tomato directly from farmers. This not only strengthens market linkages but also eliminates middlemen, ensuring fair returns for the producers. By adopting transparent pricing mechanisms, the FPC has built trust among its members, encouraging more farmers to join. Due to its efficient operations and deep engagement with the farming community, the FPC has been selected as a Community Based Organisation (CBO) under the Crop Diversification Programme (CDP) – Mega Lift Irrigation Project (MLIP) in Deogaon block of Balangir and Ulunda, BMPur of Sonepur District. This recognition underscores its credibility and potential to lead development in the region through improved cropping practices and water-use efficiency. The FPC receives support from the **Government of India**, is implemented by **NABARD - National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development**, and mentored by Mahashakti Foundation as the Cluster-Based Business Organisation (CBBO) under the Central Sector Scheme for Formation and Promotion of 10,000 FPOs.

“We believe in empowering farmers not just as cultivators, but as stakeholders in agribusiness. Our journey is about unity, trust, and growth,” says **Mr. Udaya Naik, Managing Director of Ghasiendevi FPC.**

As the company continues to expand its membership base, diversify its business portfolio, and introduce new services like farm mechanization, Ghasiendevi FPC is paving the way for a vibrant, self-reliant, and sustainable farming community in western Odisha. Its journey serves as an inspiring example of how grassroots institutions, when nurtured with the right mentorship and ecosystem support, can transform the rural economy from the ground up.
